2024 OPERATION ART EXHIBITION

Kindergarten to Year 10

Operation Art is an initiative of The Children's Hospital at Westmead in association with the New South Wales Department of Education. The program includes exhibitions, workshops and professional learning opportunities in visual arts for teachers and students from all schools in NSW.

Operation Art will be moving into an exciting new model for our exhibition program!

Heading into 2024, our **goal is to represent students and schools across the state**, celebrating their creative achievements in the most **equitable and accessible** ways possible.

All artwork entries received by schools this year will be exhibited in **galleries across NSW in 2025**, according to the regions where the students' schools are located. This will **provide easier access** for schools and families to attend **opening celebrations**, workshop programs and hospital artwork donations in galleries closer to their hometowns, enabling more of our students to see their work on display.

As always, a team of judges will select **50** artworks to be gifted to the **Children's Hospital at Westmead** and these works will continue to be displayed at the **Art Gallery of NSW** annually, as well as being displayed in their local gallery in the larger exhibitions.

Closing date for entries is: Friday, 31st May, 2024. Please leave entries at the front office, by Wednesday,22nd May, 2024, so we will have time to post artworks to Sydney.

Artwork size: Artworks can be up to A2 in size and up to 5mm thick. For more information on the 2023 Operation Art Exhibition please follow the below link: https://artsunit.nsw.edu.au/program/operation-art

<u>Entry Fee</u>: The fee this year for Government Schools is \$100.00 per artwork. Quandialla Public School will contribute \$45.00 to each entry, so parents will only need to pay \$55.00 for their child's entry.

<u>Artwork Limit</u>: Each school may submit up to <u>six works of art</u>. Please notify the school if you wish to participate in the 2024 Operation Art Exhibition. If more than 6 artworks are received, the school will make the decision on which ones to enter.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Artworks are more suitable if created on quality art paper. Please contact Mrs Gault if you require a piece of art paper for your work.


