Emily's music students will be putting on a concert on Friday at 10am to show off what they have learned during the year. Everyone is welcomed to come along.

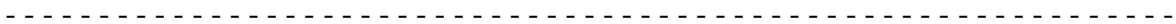

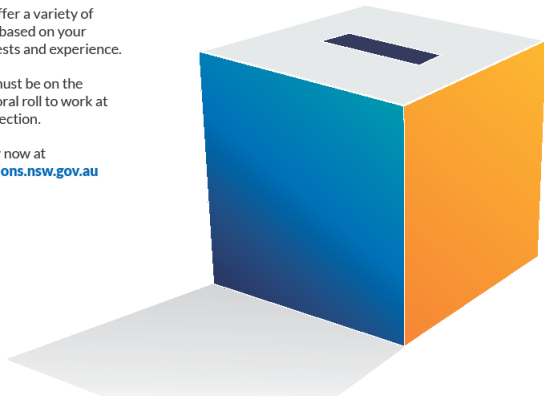
