A single School Visitor Check-in system for every school across the state commenced on Monday, 18th October, 2021.

The Department of Education has partnered with Service NSW to provide a streamlined, digital school sign-in system for visitors and contractors at every NSW government school.

- Linked to NSW Health's COVID-19 contact tracing ensuring every school is compliant with the NSW <u>COVID-19 mandate</u>.
- Giving every school greater access to streamlined NSW Government services.

Who can use School Visitor check-in

 Visitors such as parents and carers, contractors, service providers and volunteers.

Students or visitors under the age of 18 are not required to use School Visitor Checkin.

School Visitor Check-in will be ready from 18 October at all NSW Government schools.

Vaccination vans on
Thursday 28th October 2021.

The mobile clinics will be located at:

- Caragabal Nature Strip opposite Royal Hotel, Wyalong Street from 10AM 11AM
- Quandialla Blamey Park, Second Street from 11:30AM 12:30PM
- Greenethorpe Edward Square Park, opposite Post Office, Main Road from 2PM 3PM

Who can receive a vaccine at this clinic?

- No bookings needed for first doses.
 - Pfizer vaccine will be available for those aged 12 years and over.
 - Anyone aged 12-15yrs MUST BE accompanied by their parent, guardian or nominated carer.
 - If seeking a second Pfizer dose, bring evidence of your first dose.
 - We encourage students to take up this opportunity ahead of the return to face-to-face learning.
 - Those attending will need to bring a form of identification and where able, their Medicare card.
 - The queue may be long, so we encourage people to come prepared with food, drink, perhaps a portable chair, a hat & sunscreen.
 - Second dose clinics will be scheduled.

People MUST NOT ATTEND the clinic if they:

- Are waiting on a COVID-19 test result (unless this was a surveillance test only and the person is not unwell).
- Are a CONFIRMED close contact of a CONFIRMED positive COVID-19 case.
- Are unwell. Anyone with COVID symptoms should get tested & isolate until they receive a negative test
 result.
- Have had ANY other vaccination (including flu) in the previous seven days.

Could you be a Community Connector?

The Lifeline Accidental Counsellor course equips participants with the essential skills and structure to:

- · Recognise when a person is in crisis
- · Respond in an appropriate and compassionate manner, and
- · Refer the person to a suitable service

Local communities across Australia have been significantly impacted by the 2020 bushfires and COVID-19. Many people are experiencing personal challenges as a result of these difficult times.

To help communities further support each other through these challenges, Lifeline Central West is offering community members the opportunity to become a Community Connector. A Community Connector is considered to be a member of the community who has frequent access to other local members e.g. through a work environment or sporting group.

Community Connectors will have the opportunity to be trained in the Lifeline Accidental Counsellor information course at no cost, and be equipped to connect community members in need to appropriate local and national services.

Accidental Counsellor is for community members who would like to be able to safely and effectively support someone in distress or experiencing a crisis. It is an open course, with no pre-existing skills or knowledge required.

Accidental Counsellor aims to provide participants with the skills to support another in a moment of need, and the self-care tools to ensure their own wellbeing is in focus. While completion of the course does not make participants qualified counsellors, it builds confidence in how to provide appropriate support in these moments.
