2022 OPERATION ART EXHIBITION

Every year schools across New South Wales are invited to participate in Operation Art, an initiative of The Children's Hospital at Westmead in association with the New South Wales Department of Education. Entries are now open for the 2022 Operation Art Exhibition at the Armory Gallery, Sydney Olympic Park.

Closing date for entries is: Friday, 27th May, 2022. Please leave entries at the front office, so we will have time to post artworks to Sydney by Tuesday, 31st May, 2022.

Artwork size: Minimum A4 (30 x 21cm), maximum A2 (42 x 60cm), maximum depth 5mm. Please note: Artwork deeper than this limit will not be framed.

Theme: The theme of Operation Art is for students to provide artwork to help cheer up patients at The Children's Hospital at Westmead.

Curatorial Brief: As some exhibited works will eventually be hung at the Children's Hospital at Westmead, we ask that special consideration be given to ensure that the artwork submitted is uplifting and does not contain material that could be considered culturally sensitive in nature.

Entry Fee: The fee this year for Government Schools is \$95.00 per artwork. Quandialla Public School will contribute \$40.00 to each entry, so parents will only need to pay \$55.00 for their child's entry.

Artwork Limit: Each school may submit up to four works of art. Please notify the school if you wish to participate in the 2022 Operation Art Exhibition. If more than 4 artworks are received, the school will make the decision on which ones to enter.

Creating Your Work

Students may use a variety of media and materials when creating works for submission to Operation Art. All entries must be 2D forms.

Here's your chance to Cleanout ...

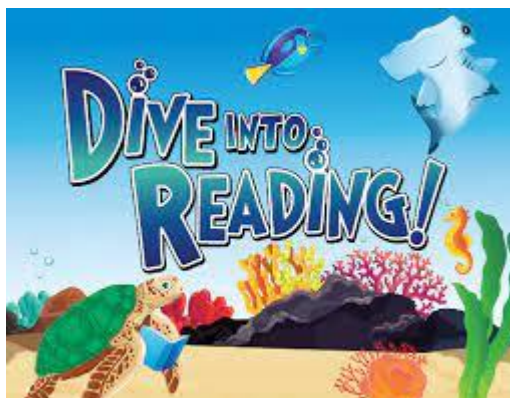
- Garden chemicals
