

2023 OPERATION ART EXHIBITION

Every year schools across New South Wales are invited to participate in Operation Art, an initiative of The Children's Hospital at Westmead in association with the New South Wales Department of Education. Entries are now open for the 2023 Operation Art Exhibition at the Armory Gallery, Sydney Olympic Park.

<u>Closing date for entries is</u>: Friday, 31st May, 2023. Please leave entries at the front office, so we will have time to post artworks to Sydney by Tuesday, 23rd May, 2023.

Artwork size: Artworks can be up to A2 in size and up to 5mm thick.

Theme: The theme of Operation Art is for students to provide artwork to help cheer up patients at The Children's Hospital at Westmead.

Curatorial Brief: As some exhibited works will eventually be hung at the Children's Hospital at Westmead, we ask that special consideration be given to ensure that the artwork submitted is uplifting and does not contain material that could be considered culturally sensitive in nature.

<u>Entry Fee</u>: The fee this year for Government Schools is \$95.00 per artwork. Quandialla Public School will contribute \$40.00 to each entry, so parents will only need to pay \$55.00 for their child's entry.

<u>Artwork Limit</u>: Each school may submit up to <u>four works of art</u>. Please notify the school if you wish to participate in the 2023 Operation Art Exhibition. If more than 4 artworks are received, the school will make the decision on which ones to enter.

Creating Your Work

Students may use a variety of media and materials when creating works for submission to Operation Art. All entries must be 2D forms.

Young Archie Dubbo

Competition

Budding artists between the ages of 5 and 18 are invited to submit a portrait for the Young Archie competition being held at the Western Plains Cultural Centre, Dubbo.

The portrait should be of a person who is special to you – someone who is known to you and plays a significant role in your life.

There are four age categories:

- 5 8 year olds
- 9 12 year olds
- 13 15 year olds
- 16 18 year olds

About your portrait subject:

It is preferred that the portrait is 'painted from life' and that your subject has a sitting for their portrait, like with the Archibald Prize. You may also create the portrait from memory or take your own photography to use for reference.

Your artwork:

- You may use any art materials you like but your artwork must be two-dimensional and on good-quality paper so it can be framed for display if you are a finalist.
- Can be vertical or horizontal.
- Must be no smaller than A4 (210 x 297 mm), no bigger than A3 (40 x 297 mm) and no thicker than 1 cm.
- Should be clearly labelled on the back with which way it should be displayed, along with your name, age, address and contact details. Make sure this doesn't show through to the front.
- <u>Please Note:</u> There is a limit on the number of entries per school, with only the top 10 artworks being sent to Dubbo. If more than 10 entries are received at Quandialla Public School, judging will take place to choose the artworks to be sent to Dubbo.

ENTRIES due during the School Holidays: If you wish to enter in this competition, please contact Mrs Gault in the front office, so a time can be arranged to have entries in during the School Holidays. Artworks will be posted to Dubbo for judging. Also, if you require art paper for you Portrait, please contact the front office.

Identified COVID-19 cases at Quandialla Public School

Dear community members

Quandialla Public School has been advised that 7 students have recently tested positive to COVID-19.

While testing and isolation is no longer mandatory for being exposed to someone with COVID-19 in school settings, NSW Health has provided advice on testing and isolation requirements for our school communities following **exposure to COVID-19** that should be considered when making decisions for your child and family if this situation arises at your school.

You are reminded that students and staff cannot attend school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19. These include fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, extreme tiredness, unexplained chest pain or conjunctivitis (eye infection).

If symptoms occur at any time, your child should not attend school and should undertake a rapid antigen test. If the rapid antigen test is positive, your child should isolate as someone who has tested positive to COVID-19.

You must register any positive test on the Service NSW website or Service NSW app so that you can be linked to important health care support and advice. Parents and carers are reminded to please ensure that you select your school name when prompted when registering a positive test for your child.

The safety and wellbeing of our students and staff across NSW are paramount at all times. As such, we will continue to ensure that all necessary health advice is closely followed.
