Stanno!



Road Safety

A number of our staff have had to speak to students regarding unsafe practices when traveling to and from school. We have also had phone calls from community members regarding students riding bikes in an unsafe manner in the middle of the road. If students are not confident riding bikes, we advise that they do not ride to school unsupervised. We are also required by law to hold bikes on school grounds if students do not have an appropriate helmet to wear.


