NAPLAN commences on Wednesday next week. NAPLAN is a nationwide standardised test to measure student growth in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar, punctuation) and numeracy. Information packs are being sent home today for affected students. Students in Year 3 and 5 sit the test - a grand total of 1 student for us this year. As a result, there will be minimal changes to school during the assessment period.
